

General Installation Notes:

**Please thoroughly read these instructions prior to starting installation.**

- Make sure that the appropriate personal protection equipment is worn while installing windows and doors. This includes protective eyewear, gloves, hard hat, safety shoes, hearing protection and clothing to protect arms and legs.
- These instructions assume that the installer is familiar with general construction methods.
- Check national, state and local building codes prior to installation to ensure proper compliance. When removing old windows or doors in preparation for installation of new product, visit [www.epa.gov/lead](http://www.epa.gov/lead) for information on the proper disposal or recycling of the products being removed.
- Tools typically required for installation:
  - Tape measure
  - Level
  - Utility knife
  - Drill/driver
  - Screw driver, flat and Phillips
  - 9" Grace Vycor Plus self-adhered flashing
  - Polyurethane sealant and sealant gun
  - Non-compressible plastic shims
  - Sill pan
- Weather-strips are components that wear through normal use. Each weather-strip should be inspected at least annually for proper seal and signs of wear or damage that could indicate the need for replacement. If replacement is required, please contact your Sierra Pacific Window Regional Service Center for assistance.
